Those statments by Beto for Texas referred to total contributions raised of \$7.2 million in the reporting period, which roughly matches the \$7,221,691.67 in monetary political contributions reflected on the January 18, 2022 campaign finance report. 80% of \$7,221,691.67 is \$5,777,353.33.

Ms. Pulido/Beto for Texas apparently only reported the contribution amount, contributor name and address, and the contribution date for contributions accepted from a person that exceeded \$90 in the reporting period, and did not include that information on any other contributions.

On information and belief, based on the claims made by Beto for Texas as reported in the news, Ms. Pulido/Beto for Texas should have reported the contributor's full name and adress, date of the contribution, and amount of the contribution for at least \$5,777,353.33 on the January 18, 2022 report, which accounts for 80% of the committee's monetary political contributions in the reporting period. Instead, on the January 18, 2022 report, Ms. Pulido/Beto for Texas only reported that information for \$5,454,824.99 of monetary political contributions. On information and belief, Ms. Pulido/Beto for Texas failed to properly report at least \$322,528.34 in electronic political contributions.

Based on the above reasons, Ms. Pulido violated Election Code Sec. 254.031(a)(1-a).

Former Rep. Beto O'Rourke (D-Texas) pulled in more than \$7.2 million for his bid for Texas governor in the six weeks since launching his campaign.

He raised more than a quarter of that money — about \$2 million — in the 24-hour period after announcing his plans to seek the Democratic nomination to take on Gov. Greg Abbott (R) in 2022. O'Rourke's latest fundraising total spans the period from Nov. 15 to Dec. 31.

The 46-day fundraising haul is a record for a Democratic candidate in Texas. No Democratic campaign in the state's history has raised so much in the opening days of a race, O'Rourke's team said.

The money came from more than 115,600 contributions, the campaign said, and 80 percent of the total was raised from online donations.

"I'm grateful to everyone who helped us raise more than \$7.2 million in the first weeks of our campaign," O'Rourke said in a statement. "While Abbott is taking million-dollar checks from the CEOs who profited off of the grid collapse, we're receiving support from people all over Texas who want to ensure that our state finally leads in great jobs, world class schools and the ability to see a doctor."

O'Rourke has proven himself time and again as one of the Democratic Party's most prolific fundraisers. He raised more than \$80 million over the

Of course, O'Rourke will still have to compete against Abbott, who had more time to raise money and has amassed a staggering war chest of his own.

Abbott's campaign announced on Tuesday that it has more than \$65 million on hand after pulling in nearly \$19 million in the six-month period spanning from July 1 to Dec. 31. The total came from nearly 159,000 contributions with an average donation size of \$119, his campaign said.
