PRIORITIZE FUNDING FOR CLASSROOMS, NOT BUREAUCRATS.

Texas has made historic investments in public education, including \$90 billion last session. Those dollars should be prioritized in the classroom - for students and teachers - not excessive bureaucracy and administrative bloat.

Governor Abbott's plan will dedicate 70% of funding for the classroom and require audits of school districts to eliminate excessive administrative costs, wasteful contracts, and fraud. The plan will also cut unnecessary administrative requirements that take time and resources away from teachers and students.

The goal is simple: Spend more education dollars in the classroom where they belong, and less on bureaucracy.
