Governor Abbott is making college more affordable and helping students start their career sooner.

His plan will cut the cost of summer courses that count toward a student's bachelor degree, helping students graduate sooner and save money along the way.

Under Governor Abbott's plan, undergraduate students at Texas public colleges and universities will receive:

- \$500 off tuition and fees when taking 1–5 credit hours during the summer.
- \$1,000 off tuition and fees when taking 6 or more credit hours during the summer.

Lower-cost summer courses mean students can make faster progress toward graduation while spending less on summer tuition. By graduating sooner, students can also save on housing and other college expenses.
